

HOMELESS VETERANS REINTEGRATION PROGRAM (HVRP)

What is HVRP?

HVRP is dedicated to supporting and serving veterans through engagement with meaningful employment opportunities in local labor force, and to ensure connections to stable housing opportunities and services. Eligible participants receive personalized workforce development services targeting job placement, workforce training, and career counseling supports.

How do I qualify?

Individuals must provide verification of the following:

- A) Active-Duty service & Discharge (Other than Dishonorable)
- B) Proof of literal homelessness, recent housing (<60-days), or enrollment with partner service (HUD-VASH, SSVF, Transition from Incarceration) *
- C) Strong motivation to engage in workforce development services, training, and active employment

**Veterans At-risk of homelessness w/n 15-60 days may also be deemed eligible.*
