A Message From Our President & CEO

As I reflect on the past year at Friendship Place, I'm filled with deep gratitude. In 2024, we faced growing challenges—homelessness in DC rose by 14%—but thanks to your support, we rose to meet them with compassion and purpose.

For the first time, we served over 5,000 people. One of our proudest achievements was the opening of The Aston, a new bridge housing facility in the West End. Designed for adults and adult family members, it allows loved ones to remain together as they rebuild their lives.

At our Welcome Center—largely funded by your generosity—over 1,200 people received food, clothing, case management, and access to medical and mental health services.

Your support also powered our AimHire Employment Program, which helped over 300 individuals with resumes, interviews, and job resources.

Beyond direct services, we continue to push for systems change. Your gifts allow us to advocate for lasting solutions at the policy level.

Behind every number is a person—like Sarah, a single mother who found stable housing through Friendship Place after the sudden loss of her husband.

Still, the need continues to grow. Rising housing costs, economic uncertainty, and systemic inequities continue to push our neighbors to the brink. But with you by our side, we will keep innovating, advocating, and walking with those who need us most.

Sarah Williams had a life anyone would envy—a wonderful son, Kyle, and a partner, Rob, the ideal father.

One day in February, Sarah's life changed forever. Rob, her partner and best friend, called to say he wasn't feeling well. Before Sarah could get home, she received another call—Rob had suffered a heart attack. "Paramedics were trying to save him, my best friend, in front of my baby boy," she remembers.

Doctors did all they could, but Rob passed away. Sarah whispered, "It's ok to let go. I promise to raise Kyle to be a good man like you."

Thrown into survival mode, Sarah focused entirely on caring for Kyle. Over time, she lost her job, her car, and eventually, her home. They stayed on friends' couches until that kindness ran out. With what little money she had left, Sarah rented a storage unit—and made it feel like "camping" for Kyle's sake. They showered at rec centers and filled their days any way they could.

Then, a woman told Sarah about the Virginia Williams Family Resource Center, which referred her to The Brooks.

At The Brooks, Sarah found warmth, safety, and beds—their first in months. Kyle loved the playground and made friends. The staff welcomed them with open arms. No longer in survival mode, Sarah could finally plan for the future.

Two months later, with help from the Brooks team, Sarah signed a lease. "Home is such a beautiful word," she says. "And The Brooks made it happen."

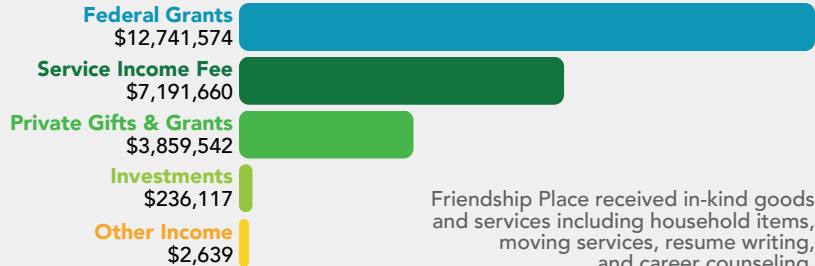
Now, Sarah shares her story to give hope to others. "I promised myself I'd never take this for granted—and I'd pay it forward every day."

And today, Rob's picture rests where it belongs—in their new home.

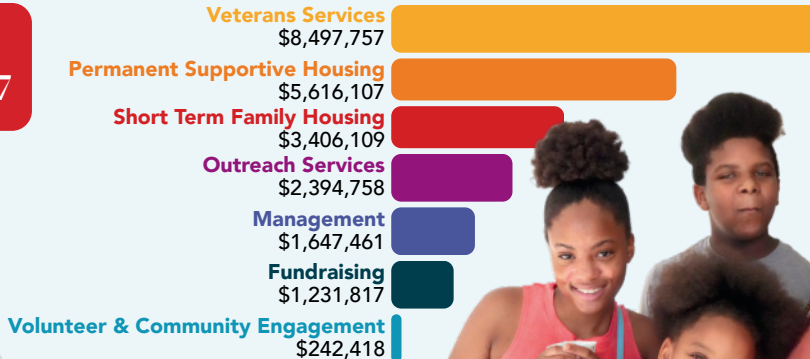


Numbers & Impact Fiscal Year 2024

Programs & Impact

Permanent Supportive Housing

Served 1,117 highly vulnerable, chronically homeless people throughout the District. Our PSH case managers provide continued support to empower participants to achieve personal goals for recovery, health, financial stability, family reunification, work, and social well-being. open from PSH programs have a housing retention rate of 97%.

Short-Term Housing

Housed 167 families, including 340 children at our Brooks Short-Term Family Housing facility in Ward 3 serving families experiencing homelessness. Our Short-Term Bridge Housing facility, Valley Place, housed 161 individuals.

Veterans Services

Our award-winning Veterans First program served 752 veterans and their family members throughout DC and eight surrounding counties, successfully housing 95%.

Drop-in Center

Hosted 1,219 visitors at our Welcome Center, which provides a place of refuge from the street and where anyone can find assistance obtaining housing and vital documents. The Welcome Center also provides access to essentials such as food, mail, and survival/ hygiene kits.

Free Clinic

Provided free medical or psychiatric assessments.

Job Placement

Using an innovative 'jobs first' fast-track model, the AimHire Division served 337 people, including 88 veterans, at risk of or experiencing homelessness, and placed 74% into jobs. Participants earned an average starting wage of \$19.59 per hour.

Youth and Young Adult Services

Provided developmentally-informed services, including financial literacy, health and wellness, housing assistance, education bar, education and employment. Our Youth Street Outreach program conducted street outreach to 256 runaway, homeless, and at-risk youth (ages 17-24), distributing survival/ hygiene kits, vital documents, mental health services, and housing assessments to connect them with District housing providers. Our Lift and Lift Plus programs served 35 youth, providing Rapid-Rehousing and Transitional Housing to transition age youth.

Adult Street Outreach

Served 74 individuals.



In Fiscal Year 2024, Friendship Place served 5,430 participants, including 1,495 kids and 752 veterans.

In 2024, Friendship Place also secured jobs for 140 people.

Over 5,400 of our neighbors—including families, youth, seniors, and veterans—overcame homelessness or remained safely housed with the help of Friendship Place in 2024. Friendship Place provides essential services that help people rebuild their lives. Through education and advocacy, we also engage with the root causes of homelessness, in order to end homelessness for good.
